

Mifflin West District of CNI
MEETING MINUTES
Thursday, September 10, 2009

In attendance: Rick & Diane Broughman, Dory & Ole Christensen, Brandon Cook,

Larry Warman called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. at the Madison Senior Center, following a larger meeting by the Madison City Planning staff, who presented new ideas for our Downtown District policy of land use and building.

Minutes of the August meeting of Mifflin West were approved by voice vote.

After a brief discussion of the earlier meeting, it was decided not to take a position yet as to the new plan. We want to know more and will discuss what we would like to see in the plan (regarding building heights and roundabouts, etc.).

Next, Larry asked Ruth what she wanted the group to consider. She suggested Mifflin West apply for a City grant next year. It would fund, if approved, for permanent signs showing the location of Mifflin West district of CNI. She passed around photos she had taken of the Bassett and First Settlement signs. There was interest and she made a motion that we investigate the possibilities. Dory seconded the motion. Alder Mike Verveer, Brandon, Dory and Ruth agreed to work on it. Application deadline is late February or March. Report to be brought back to another meeting of Mifflin West.

Rick is interested in a new CNI sign for the Farmer's Market table for next summer, if it is to be used again next year. The current one needs updating. The list of CNI districts should be 5 not 6. State Langdon is no longer in CNI. Also, wind is a factor on this sign.

The next meeting of Mifflin West will be Wednesday, October 14th at 6:30 p.m. at the Library.

Ruth made a motion to adjourn. Diane seconded it. Meeting was adjourned.
